With a large and enthusiastic group of parent volunteers, BHCC serves to support the students, parents, teachers, and staff at Bret Harte Middle School.


Besides the meetings, BHCC holds fun and educational events and workshops throughout the year.



Single Event Volunteer – one who voluntarily provides a service to the school district without compensation, for a single event which will be completed in (1) school day or less. (Fingerprints NOT REQUIRED if directly and constantly supervised by certificated staff; or is volunteering in a capacity that does not include helping students directly for one day or less. If a volunteer intends to volunteer for more than 1x "Single Event", that volunteer must seek District "clearance".
